>>> Task

- I. Pupils to work in groups of 3-5 people.
- 2. Pupils are arranged to sit in a circle.
- 3. The teacher will pass a ball to a pupil in the group. The pupil will talk about his or her favourite indoor or outdoor game.
- 4. The pupil then passes the ball to another group member. That group member talks about his or her favourite indoor or outdoor game too.
- **5.** In this way, the ball is passed around the group until all group members have spoken about their favourite indoor or outdoor game.



Activity 2


>>> Task

- 1. Pupils have already read or researched in groups or individually.
- 2. A pupil is chosen to take on a role or character; for example, as 'Florence Nightingale'.
- 3. Ask pupil to sit in a chair specially prepared for the 'role'.
- 4. Pupil answers questions about the character or role from classmates or team members.

Suggested answers:

- I. Who was Florence Nightingale? She was a nurse.
- 2. Where was her birthplace? She was born in Florence, Italy.
- 3. What did she do in Turkey?
 She took care of wounded soldiers.
- 4. What was she known as?
 She was known as 'The Lady with the Lamp'.
- 5. How did she get this title?

 She would carry a lantern at night to visit the wounded soldiers.
- **6.** What is the name of the award given to Florence Nightingale? She was awarded with the Order of Merit.



>> Task

- I. Ask pupils to find a partner.
- 2. Pupils stand in two circles facing their partners.
- 3. Give a question or task to pupils in Circle I.
- 4. Pupils in Circle 2 will answer and partner listens.
- **5.** Pupils in Circle I will praise or correct the answer given by their partners when their partner finished giving the answer.
- 6. Pupils then exchange role for the following question or task.
- 7. Finally, pupils will change partners with the pupil next to them.

Suggested answers:


- I. What is the name of the longest river in Malaysia? It is Sq Rajang in Sarawak.
- 2. What is the name of the historical city in Malaysia? Melaka.
- 3. Where is Mount Kinabalu? It is in Sabah.
- 4. What is the name of the sea that separates Peninsular Malaysia from Sabah and Sarawak? The South China Sea.
- **5.** What is the state capital of Sarawak? Kuching.
- **6.** What is the state capital of Sabah? Kota Kinabalu.






Task

- 1. Pupils are divided into groups of 3-4 persons each.
- 2. Pupils are given a topic to discuss 'What are the Ways to Save Money?'
- 3. To speak or to give an opinion, group members have to put a chip into a box in the middle of the group.
- 4. Members are allowed to speak a second time when everyone in the group has taken their turns to speak.



>>> Task

- I. Pupils to work in pairs.
- 2. Pupils are given a question 'How to protect yourself on social media?'
- 3. Each pupil thinks about the question and writes down his or her ideas.
- 4. Pupils share their ideas with their partners.
- 5. Pupils share their ideas with their classmates.



Suggested answers:

How to protect yourself on social media?

- 1. Never give personal information such as name, age and address.
- 2. Do not reveal your daily activities.
- 3. Do not add people you do not know.
- 4. Do not text people you do not know.
- 5. Do not post pictures of yourself.

>>> Task

- I. Pupils to work in groups of 3-4 people.
- 2. Pupils to list down the ways to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- 3. Pupils to make a poster on How to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19.
- **4.** Pupils may use materials such as a manila card, large piece of paper, pencil, colored pencil or water colors.
- **5.** Make the poster as attractive as possible.

Sample poster:

HOW TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19



Wear a mask when in public places







Maintain 2-meter gap between each other

Cover mouth or nose when coughing or sneezing





Seek medical attention if unwell

>> Task

- **I.** Pupils work in pairs.
- 2. Pupils are given two pictures.
- 3. Each pupil writes down the similarities and differences of the pictures.
- **4.** Pupils compare their list with each other.
- **5.** Pupils exchange partners and compare their answers.

Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad, Kuala Lumpur



The Stadthuys, Melaka

Suggested answer:

Similarities:

Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad or Sultan Abdul Samad Building is a major landmark in Kuala Lumpur whereas The Stadthuys is a major landmark in Melaka. Both are historical, colonial buildings, with a clock tower each.

Differences:

Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad has a copper dome on top of the clock tower but the Stadthuys has a tiled roof.

The Stadthuys has a red exterior compared to Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad which has a pink exterior.

Activity 8 Stir the Class

>>> Task

- 1. Pupils are divided into groups. Each group member is given a number.
- 2. Pupils sit in their own groups in a circle.
- **3.** All groups are given a time limit to solve a problem.
- **4.** Pupils discuss how to solve a problem.
- **5.** When someone has a solution, other member(s) who agree to the solution will stand up to show agreement.
- **6.** When the time is up, the bell rings and a number is called.
- 7. The pupil with the number called will move to another group to solve a new problem.

Suggested answer:

I. You have been waiting for quite a while for your mother to fetch you after school. What should you do?

Solution:

Inform the teacher-in-charge so that she could telephone your mother. / Keep waiting because your mother may be delayed by traffic and will arrive late.

2. A classmate has been bullied by an older boy. The boy asks your classmate to pay for his food every day. What will you advise your classmate?

Solution:

Advise your classmate to speak to her parents.

Advise your classmate to speak to the school counsellor or class teacher.
