
Topic	Theme	Core Value	PAK-2I

#### Objectives:

- I. Knowledge: State ways to keep the school clean.
- 2. Socioemotional: Show pride in keeping the cleanliness and orderliness of the school.
- 3. Action: Care and maintain cleanliness of the school.

### Activities

- I. Pupils to work in pairs.
- 2. Teacher to tell pupils to study the pictures given. Then pupils to discuss together what they should do if they were in each situation.
- 3. Teacher to ask the pupils to list down their answers on a piece of paper.
- 4. Then pupils must shout out the answer when teacher asks the class.



### Suggested answer:

- I. If my classroom was dirty, I would clean by sweeping the floor and wiping the desks.
- 2. If there were dirty dishes on the canteen table, I would help to clear it.
- 3. If there were books and magazines scattered on the library table I will help to put them back or arrange them neatly.
- 4. If there was rubbish all over the school field, I would help to pick it up.





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- I. Knowledge: Explain ways of taking care of personal hygiene.
- 2. Socioemotional: Embrace self-love by practicing a healthy lifestyle for the well-being of everyone.
- 3. Action: Practice proper techniques of washing hands before and after meals.

### Activities

- I. Pupils to work in groups.
- 2. Each group must create a poster on How to Take Care of Personal Hygiene.
- 3. Pupils will need an A3 sized manila card, pens and other materials to make the poster.
- 4. After completing the poster, pupils to display their poster to the class.
- **5.** Then each group must write positive comments and suggestions on sticky notes and to paste it on the poster.



- I. Knowledge: State ways to curb bullying.
- 2. Socioemotional: Express love for members of the school community.
- **3.** Action: Report cases of bullying in school.

### Activities

- I. Pupils to work in groups.
- 2. The teacher gives a newspaper report about a pupil being bullied at school.
- **3.** Based on the newspaper report, the teacher asks pupils to discuss how to stop bullying in schools.
- 4. One pupil from each group writes down the ideas provided in a bubble map.
- 5. After discussion is over, one student from each group to present the ideas to the class.

- I. Knowledge: Explain the importance of preserving and conserving nature.
- 2. Socioemotional: Instill awareness in preserving and conserving nature.
- 3. Action: Preserve and conserve nature.

#### Activities

- I. Pupils to work in pairs.
- 2. The teacher shows a poster to the pupils. The poster is about a funfair to raise money to save the orangutan from going extinct.
- 3. Teacher to discuss with pupils about this event.
- 4. Pupils to think of other ways that people can save the orangutans and list them down.
- 5. Give pupils 10 minutes to think and write down their ideas.
- 6. After that, teacher to ask pupils to share ideas with their class.



- I. Pupils to work in pairs.
- 2. Role-play the following situations:

#### Situation 1:

You see your mother cooking lunch. You offer to help her.

#### Situation 3:

You see your brother doing his school project. You offer to help him.

#### Situation 2:

You see your father washing his car. You offer to help him.

#### Situation 4:

You see your grandmother doing the gardening. You offer to help her.

# Sample of role play:

Lina: Hi, mom! Are you cooking for lunch?

Mom: Hi, Lina! Yes I am.

Lina: Do you need any help?

Mom: Yes, please. Could you please cut the carrots?

Lina: Sure, mom. Where are the carrots?

Mom: They are in the refrigerator. The knife and chopping board are at the kitchen

table.

Lina: Ok, I got it.

Mom: Thank you for offering to help.

Lina: It's my pleasure mom. Will you need me to do anything else after I have cut the

carrots?

Mom: Yes, can you please help me to wash up?

Lina: Sure mom.



- I. Knowledge: State the various sources of income or alternative sources (ang pow, birthday gifts, scholarship, rewards).
- 2. Socioemotional: Appreciate the sources of income received.
- 3. Action: Be responsible in making financial decisions.

## Activities

- I. Pupils to work in groups.
- 2. Pupils to sit in a circle.
- 3. Teacher to provide a ball to each group.
- 4. The pupil who holds the ball must give one source of income.
- **5.** He/she then passes the ball to the pupil sitting next to them and the next pupil must state another source of income.
- 6. The ball is passed around until all the pupils have given their answer.
- 7. The leader of the group then reads out the answer in class.




