General Tips for Listening Exam

Part 1 and Part 2

- 1. Make sure you read the instructions carefully so that you know what to do.
- **2.** Before the recording starts, read through the questions and answers quickly. Usually, they will tell you a lot about what the speaker is going to talk about.
- **3.** Underline the key words in the question.
- 4. Think of the type of information that you will hear. The questions may need you to:
 - · understand main and specific information.
 - identify attitudes and opinions of how someone feels about a situation or a person.
 - understand simple to more complex narratives that cover a variety of topics.
 - guess the meaning of words from the clues provided.
- **5.** While listening, listen for key words that might be said by the speaker or any paraphrased words. The speakers may not use the same words as those in the answer options. Sometimes you might have to look for synonyms or words of similar meaning.
- **6.** Be careful of the distractors where they may use the words that might appear in the recordings but they are not the answer.
- 7. Don't guess your answer too quickly. It is better to listen carefully to the whole recording.
- 8. Look at the answer options and choose the best option.
- 9. When the recording is played again, check your answer.



Questions 1 to 7

You will hear people talking in seven different situations. For questions **1 to 7**, choose the correct answer (**A, B**, or **C**).

You will hear each recording **twice**. Answer all the questions.

- 1. The man trained for the long run
 - (A) after he was fully prepared.
 - **B** after he trained for 15 weeks
 - **C** after he finished running short distances.
- 2. What did the man feel about his job?
 - **A** Fear
 - **B** Proud
 - (C) Worthwhile





- 3. The man loves travelling because
 - (A) he can experience varieties of cultures and beliefs.

Comments and Answer

- 1. The answer is A. The speaker said she started to train for the long run when she was ready. Moreover, the word that has a similar meaning to ready is 'prepared'.
- 2. The answer is C. You have to listen to the whole recording. The speaker said towards the end the job is meaningful which can have a similar meaning to 'worthwhile'.
- 3. The answer is A. You need to listen carefully to the recording. Some of the words in the answer options are being said by the speaker in the recording. So, it can be confusing. But the main reason for the speaker to love travelling is that she could see people of different cultures, beliefs and their way of life. The answer option is A only paraphrase the sentence.
- 4. The answer is A. The speaker said she created the garden in her backyard and that she has limited space. Hence, answer options B and C are incorrect as she did not talk about vegetable seeds and she already planted various types of vegetables. 'Small piece of land' is similar to 'limited space'.
- 5. The answer is B. The words in the answer option are said by the speaker. However, answer options A and C are not correct as they are not what the speaker means. In option B, the phrase 'need some time away' has a similar meaning to 'take a break'.
- 6. The answer is C. You have to listen to the whole recording and interpret the answer from the whole information. The answer could be A and B, but option C provides a more precise answer. He was stubborn because he didn't listen to his parents and he was problematic because he got into a lot of trouble
- 7. The answer is A. The speaker said the family was watching television and ran outside when the roof was ripped off.

Comments and Answer

- 1. The answer is C. The speaker used the word potable for the smartphone which means easy to carry around.
- 2. The answer is B. All of the answer options are said by the speaker. You need to listen carefully to the whole idea about lighting to answer this question. Flash and overexpose light are not good lighting suggestions expressed by the speaker.
- 3. The answer is C. The speaker said to understand how lighting affects the photos, one needs to take photos of the same subject at different angles. So, the answer is C. Option C also replaces the word 'affect' with 'changes'.
- 4. The answer is A. The speaker said adding layers is to add interest and guide the viewer to your subject. The only close answer to this is option A where they replaced 'add' with 'create'. Options B and C are distractors where the speaker said this in the recording.
- 5. The answer is C. The speaker stated the background can be patterns, objects and anything behind the subject. The only thing that is not said by him is the subject.
- 6. The answer is B. The speaker said to turn on the gridlines for the phone camera in settings to practice aligning photos. The word 'turn on' is also replaced with the synonym 'activate'. Answer options A and C are how to use the rule of third.
- 7. The answer is C. Options A and B are incorrect as they are not the advice for how to mix the angles when taking photos. Option C is one of the ways to mix up the angles stated by the speaker.
- 8. The answer is C. You have to choose the one that is not related to photography skills. The speaker mentioned editing the photo for social media purposes only.
