#### **K-Pop Fever**

K-Pop has become a global phenomenon after two decades. This phenomenon is known as Hallyu-'Korean wave' is a term used to describe how the South Korean culture from their dramas, reality shows, songs, food, singers, actors, actresses and skincare products have left a great influence on the whole world.

Historically, in 1992, 'Seo Taiji and Boys', a South Korean band performed a song entitled 'I know' live on a television talent contest. They made a bold move when they tried to mix different genres of music in their song. They used Korean lyrics with European pop and hip-hop as well as rap. It was a new 'brand' of music arena but luck was not on their side. The judges weren't fond of it and thus they were eliminated from the contest.

However, there was a breaking news on their song. 'I Know' has become a hit and placed number one in the Korean chart, only after 17 weeks of the contest. Not long after that, the Korean entertainment industry grew to be the most influential target to all people in the world, especially teenagers.

K-Pop, or known as Korean popular music is an eye-opener because it mixes different music genres like hip hop, electronic dance, jazz and rock. Most of the songs are presented by groups consisting of two to 21 members. From an interview conducted with the K-Pop members, there are several challenges in their journey to become famous. One of them is their payment issue. According to them, usually, the salary will be given only when they achieve the mega hit which sometimes takes a few years. Long contract with a company is also an issue. A seven-year contract (usually) seems too long and it frequently leads to the disbandment of the group.

Besides that, most K-pop idols complain about not getting enough rest. Once they debut an album, they have to work hard to promote their songs. They are also expected to appear on reality shows or TV shows for the public to know their faces. Not only that, they were also trained to be disciplined in their diet and time. They had to limit their food intake to keep good body shape, other than their health.

BTS, BLACKPINK, TWICE, Wonder Girls, Girls Generation, EXO, SHINee and Super Junior are among the well-known bands in South Korea. These bands did not take long to be famous. For example, Bangtan Boys (BTS) which debuted in 2013 has become famed up until now. Every single album released was a triumph and eye-opener to all South Koreans and all the Aseans. Their popularity does not only spread in the Asean countries, they also have gone to the international level. In February 2020 for instance, they became the guest in a special episode with Jimmy Fallon on Tonight Show. The show was aired with BTS performing 'ON' at the Grand Central Terminal.

BTS was also the first Korean band to perform at the American Music Awards which was later introduced to millions of Western viewers and audiences. The band continued to chart internationally, breaking records, selling out tours and releasing their first English-language single called 'Dynamite'. The song topped the Billboard charts after it was released in 2020.

Other groups that went international was Big Bang which debuted in 2006 and Black Pink who debuted in 2016. 'How You Like That' and 'Du Du Du' are among the top songs by the famous band this decade, Black Pink. From children to teenagers, everyone listened to their songs and could not resist from following their dance choreography which is modern and ecstatic.



In a survey conducted at a university, most of the students responded that the strong dance rhythm brought by the Korean bands has made them fall for it. Meanwhile, Korean bands usually have a large group of members (4-20 members). It is believed that the formation of large group is to vary the idols to be chosen by the K-Pop fans.

In addition, K-pop has also brought a hybrid sound with a unique style. The combination of jazz, soul, hip hop and funk, combined with their colourful, elegant and sophisticated clothing have made the K-Pop bands a great influence on the youngsters nowadays.

Being a K-Pop band is not easy. As mentioned earlier, they had very disciplined training in choreography. Besides, every member of the band needs to practise their vocal with the experts as well as train for live performances. All their training is conducted and monitored by their agency. Some changes like placing the members into certain groups, choosing any members to be a solo singer and etc should be expected by them. They need to practise dancing every day to ensure every single movement complements their song.
