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## USAGE

**could/may/might**

- to say something is possible but not certain

**can't**

- to say something is impossible

**must**

- to show we know something is true (and there are reasons for this suggestion)

**should**

- to suggest something is true (and there are reasons for this suggestion)

**have to**

- when we talk about obligations (things we have no choice about doing)

**need to**

- when we talk about things that are necessary to do in order to achieve a goal

**would rather**

- to show preference for one thing over another thing

**had better**

- to give advice about specific over another thing

**should and ought to**

- **should** and **ought to** are similar but **should** is used more than **ought to**.
- We used **should** and **ought to** to talk about obligation and give advice.
